

## German Pavillon at the EXPO`92, Seville, Spain

Essential feature of the building`s design which underlines the communicative aspect is the double layer membrane ellipse that hovers like a cloud over the pavillon. The "glassy" curtain of the entrance area consists of a filigree cable net facade and overlapping acrylic panels. In order to protect the visitors from the heat of Seville, the back wall of the building is made of laminated, insulating membrane elements.
