

Cooperative Comprehensive School in Neustadt am Rügenberge

In November 2001 saw the completion of the outdoor sports pavilion for the Cooperative Comprehensive School in Neustadt am Rügenberge which was co-financed by the Land Lower-Saxony as a pilot project. Since then, an attractive textile roof structure makes it possible for the students to exercise sports in the open air, no matter what the weather.

In its current design, the roof covers a total asphalt surface of 930 sq.m. This surface is divided into a multi-functional field with the dimensions of 18 x 30 metres (basketball, streetball, soccer, inline-hockey...) and a skating range including a halfpipe.

Unlike a conventional gymnasium, the outdoor sports pavilion can also be used for open-air events, concerts, school celebrations or even as an ice rink in the winter. And during daily school routine, the outdoor sports pavilion not only provides attractive options for physical education, but also represents a much appreciated expansion of the recreation hall.
