

## Wincor Nixdorf – Luminous panel in-house exhibition in Paderborn

Various decoration elements in textile design were used again in the framework of the complete conversion of the in-house exhibition at Wincor Nixdorf International GmbH in Paderborn, Germany.

A luminous panel of approximately 45 m in length indicates the ideal pathway for visitors of the exhibition.



The U-shaped light box hanging from the ceiling, completes the colourfully accentuated floor design. The light box was built and assembled as a complete set, including all mounting parts such as dimmable luminous elements, mirror foils and stainless steel frames.

In order to accentuate Wincor Nixdorf GmbH's various segment groups, another 14 light boxes were created as hollow bodies, discreetly illuminating the product range through the CENO-Style T-Lux 21.
