Material	approx. 1,700 slats cut from plastic-coated polyester material, colour white, in part printed for the logo. Width of the strips 0.1 m, length up to 21.0 m
Design	The KTP architects' concept was intended to already provide visitors with an open, transparent insight into the installation premises from a distance, however providing clear orientation with optical framing. "The logical and simple approach is to create a space-forming and binding element for the unordered and confusing complexity of the construction machinery programme. The installation area is surrounded by a free-standing 15-meter-high filter which is raised 5 metres above the ground and consists of a steel construction which appears to be wrapped with a hand's width of textile, semi-transparent strip. The filter provides a free view of the terrain with a good long-distance effect, is a logo carrier and functions as a neutral exhibition background for the exhibits."
