

"Weltwissen" – an exhibition in the Martin-Gropius-Building, Berlin

The "WeltWissen" [World Knowledge] exhibition in the Martin-Gropius-Bau [Martin Gropius Building] shows multi-faceted nature of past and current research. Fascinating collectors' items, large productions and numerous media bring the Berlin science's big ideas and discoveries to life.

A large textile wall covering through the entire room, on which shadowed projections of small and large objects are to be seen, only turns out to be an immensely dimensioned shelf when you enter the interior.

Animals, plants, sculptures and books are exhibited in 104 compartments on an area exceeding 500 square metres. The installation illustrates systematics such as the sectional characteristics of scientific work.
