

## Temporary art and music pavilion - White Noise



A mobile art pavilion was constructed at Mozartplatz for the 2011 biennial in Salzburg, the so-called "White Noise". This 18 x 10 x 7 meter large, sculptured construction is the winning project of an international competition projected by SOMA architects, and should be constructed in the future at many locations as a cultural venue and meeting place. Its hedgehog-like, prickly construction from 1500 alum. rods forms the supporting structure, a specially fabricated membrane of 5 different cutouts forms the inside skin.
