

## Membrane roof for the "Rhein-Galerie" Ludwigshafen

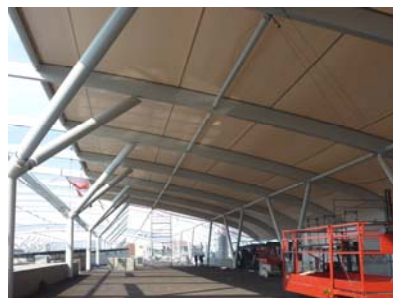


The "Rhein-Galerie" directly on the bank of the Rhine is a new kind of inner-city quarter with a shopping centre (having a sales area of approx. 30,000 m<sup>2</sup>), a gastronomy pavilion as well as a restored historical shipyard hall. Furthermore, approx. 25,000 m<sup>2</sup> of outdoor facilities with a high-grade design having direct access to the water will be produced.

A translucent membrane roof construction spanning the complete shopping mall which is to be illuminated by night give a unique and unmistakable character upon the spectacular architecture.

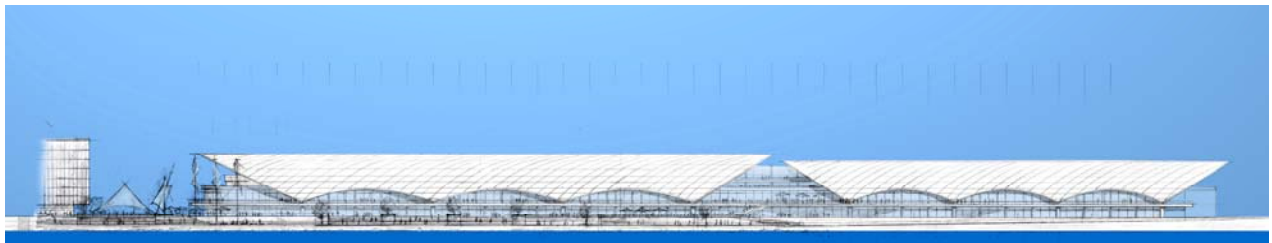
